



Rocket and was effective on vehicles and bunkers alike. This kit contains the tube with 2 demil cuts, side hole cut equal to the bore diameter (ATF required), and a GI M9 Optical Sight which is very similar to the original sight which has been emoved. This is a project to reassemble for non firing dummy/ display purposes. Tube is aluminum and some areas of the Bazooka will need splicing or re-fabrication like the firing grip ssy, loading/firing housing, and sight mount which was rough ly removed.
